Shakhtar became the Champions of Ukraine for the fourth season in a row and for the 13th time in their history. We had a great season in European competitions! Our decent performance in the Champions League group stage and playing in the Europa League semi-finals is the result we can and should be proud of. And most importantly, throughout the season the team have showcased some truly spectacular performance, delighting the fans with attacking and goal-rich football.

We believed in this specialist, in his experience and ideas, and he made Shakhtar even stronger. I am also very glad that Darijo Srna rejoined us in a new capacity in the 2019/20 season. I know for sure that his expertise and passion

We found it particularly difficult during the quarantine, but we coped with it thanks to the management and coaching staff, thanks to our players and, of course, to every staff member at the club. Last season, Shakhtar proved again that they are the leaders of Ukrainian football. For the fourth time in a row and for the 13th time in their history, the team have won gold medals in the domestic league. The philosophy of our club includes the goals of setting trends and developing the football culture in the country. And we manage to do this year after year thanks to our systematic approach, the correctly chosen strategy, planning and well-coordinated work in all directions.

Shakhtar became the champions of Ukraine with a record lead over the second-spot side. Starting from the very first rounds, the team showed with their winning streak that they were ready to achieve the maximum result. At the same time, some new players joined the squad recently - they, along with more experienced players, have made a great contribution to this season's victories. Our ambition is to develop young footballers, the Academy boys. Some of them already play in the first team, with the younger graduates topping the U21 and U19 leagues before the season was stopped.

The work of Shakhtar's new coaching staff headed by Luis Castro deserves a special mention. I want to thank Mr Castro and his assistants for their professionalism, ambition, will to win and the ability to correctly convey their vision of football to the players. Their hard work from day one confirmed the obvious thing: our choice of the coach is fully dictated by the system approach and it corresponds to the club philosophy. Shakhtar play some beautiful, spectacular football, they know how to overcome difficulties, analyze mistakes and get better.

Aggregately, we have not suffered any league defeats for nearly two years, with the unbeaten run lasting 48 games. The team had an excellent season, and its result is not only well-deserved gold medals, but also more personal awards. Junior Moraes won the Premier League scoring race again, cementing the status of a high-profile forward by his consistency and efficiency. Taison received the Best Player award and Andriy Pyatov won the country's Best Goalkeeper award.

In the Champions League, Manchester City extraordinarily became Shakhtar's opponents for the third year in a row. This time, we managed to claim points in Manchester thanks to the full dedication and teamwork. The matches against Atalanta and Dinamo Zagreb turned out to be very entertaining and exciting. In Italy, Shakhtar managed to snatch a late win, while in Croatia they saved the game and scored twice in stoppage time. Our Europa League campaign was interrupted by a break of several months due to the COVID-19 pandemic. However, this did not negatively affect the team who made it past Benfica, Wolfsburg and Basel in great style and played in the semi-finals of this prestigious competition again.

In April, Shakhtar was the first football club in Ukraine to launch a club TV channel available on major media platforms. In the first three months of broadcasting, Shakhtar TV's audience reached 1.2 million people.

The club is doing everything to be closer to its fans not only in the communications field, but also in terms of its corporate social responsibility. Charitable initiatives are implemented as part of the activities of Shakhtar Social Foundation. The biggest children's grassroots football project in Ukraine called Come On, Let's Play! has expanded its geographic reach, being present in 36 settlements now. In November it was recognized as Europe's best CSR initiative, and in December it received a UN award in the Society category.

However, more important than any awards are the number of children having the opportunity to play football for free, their genuine emotions and joy. By investing in children today, we invest into the health of the country and shape our future.

You can read more about the club's operations in the 2019/20 season in the traditional annual report. We have new challenges, important matches and big goals ahead, and I am sure that Shakhtar will get just stronger!

## Donbass Arena

Since August 2009, Donbass Arena has been Shakhtar's home ground for five seasons. However, after the beginning of the military conflict in Donbass, the team cannot hold their games there.

From 2014 through 2017, the stadium served as a logistic facility of the Aid+Help Humanitarian Centre. In March 2017, FC Shakhtar announced a total loss of control over the Donbass Arena.

### OSK Metalist

In the 2019/20 season, Shakhtar played home games at the OSK Metalist in Kharkiv. In total, there were 15 matches: 11 in the Ukrainian Championship, 3 in the Champions League and 1 in the Europa League. Aggregately, 182,669 spectators attended them (the average is 12,178). The highest attendance was registered at the Champions League encounter Shakhtar v Manchester City (36,675 fans). The Orange-and-Blacks claimed 11 wins, drew twice and lost twice.

Anyone who sees those numbers in the league table, might think it was easy. But no one gave us anything, we achieved this on our own - through our dedication, ambition and respect for each other. That's a huge number of days of labour of one family to win the title. And in the end, we had a sense of accomplishment. We are delighted to see our happy fans, team staff, administration, the president and, of course, the coaching staff. The Shakhtar family is happy. We've added another trophy to the great club's collection!

And my guys fully deserved to reach the Europa League semis. We delivered an excellent European campaign and beat the strong opponents Benfica, Wolfsburg and Basel in the knockout stages. We amassed 14 goals in five games against them - it was fantastic! Throughout the season, Shakhtar have showcased their strength, character, ambition and will to win. We stopped just a step away from the final - our only defeat outside Ukraine happened in the encounter with Internazionale.

We have covered a very difficult but successful way. I hope this will continue. There is always an opportunity to grow, we are able to get better. The team can step it up - for this we work every day. I believe we will be successful to give the club of Shakhtar only what it deserves. We will continue developing young players by displaying quality football. Everyone deserves it!

# SEASON REVIEW

Shakhtar participated in five competitions (the Super Cup, the Ukrainian Championship and Cup, the UEFA Champions League and Europa League), ultimately winning the UPL gold medals for the 13th time in their history and reaching the Europa League semi-finals.

### Ukrainian Championship

Shakhtar began playing with the new coaching staff at the helm. Paulo Fonseca and his assistants left the club, with Luis Castro being appointed as the head coach - this is his first experience of working outside Portugal. In the UPL, the Miners started with an impressive streak of 11 victories, including seven clean sheets. For the second time in their history, the Orange-and-Blacks won all games in the nominal first stage: in the 2012/13 season, there were 16 participant teams in the Championship (15 straight wins), with 12 participants last season (11 straight wins).











By the end of October, Shakhtar were the only club in the whole of Europe to have not lost a single point in their domestic league. The reigning champions left for the winter break with 16 wins, two draws and being 14 points clear of their closest pursuers. The team delivered impressive performance by scoring 50 goals, with the rest of the teams not even reaching a 40-goal mark.

In February 2020, the Orange-and-Blacks extended their unbeaten league run to 48 games and then cemented their lead in the table. In the spring, the second UPL stage kicked off: their rivals were five more clubs from the top of the table, although there was a two and a half months break between rounds 23 and 24 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The league campaign resumed in late May with an important 3-1 victory over Dynamo. Shakhtar won all four Premier League games against their archrivals, with the final lead over the latter reaching the record 23 points. The club won the league title for the 13th time in its history and once again proved itself as a clear leader in Ukrainian football.

### European competitions

The team started its European campaign in the Champions League group stage. For the third year in a row, the Miners' opponents have been the English side Manchester City, with the Italian Atalanta and Croatian Dinamo Zagreb being the other two sides in the quartet.

Luis Castro's men defeated Atalanta 2-1 away after scoring a late decider. The game in Zagreb was fantastic in terms of its intensity. By the 90th minute, Dinamo were leading 3-1, but Shakhtar managed to equalize in stoppage time: Moraes finished off Kovalenko's delivery, with Pyatov then earning a spot-kick in the opposing penalty area and with Tete converting it coolly (3-3). For the first time ever, the Miners earned a point in Manchester after the game on the City's pitch ended in a 1-1 draw, with Manor Solomon netting one for Shakhtar just like he did in Italy.

Claiming the third spot in the Champions League group allowed the Miners to continue the season in the Europa League. Their performance turned out to be one of the most successful in history - Shakhtar reached the semi-final stage for the third time (back in 2009, the Donetsk team eventually raised a European trophy - the UEFA Cup).

In the Round of 32, Shakhtar beat the strong Portuguese Benfica on aggregate (2-1 in Kharkiv and 3-3 in Lisbon). In the Round of 16, they defeated the German Wolfsburg (2-1 away and 3-0 at home). Starting from the quarter-finals, all the Europa League rounds comprised one-leg ties. Shakhtar confidently beat the Swiss Basel (4-1 in Gelsenkirchen), but stopped competing just a step away from the final (losing 0-5 to Inter in Dusseldorf). Junior Moraes scored four goals in the competition, Alan Patrick netted three, with Taison being included in the Europa League squad of the season.

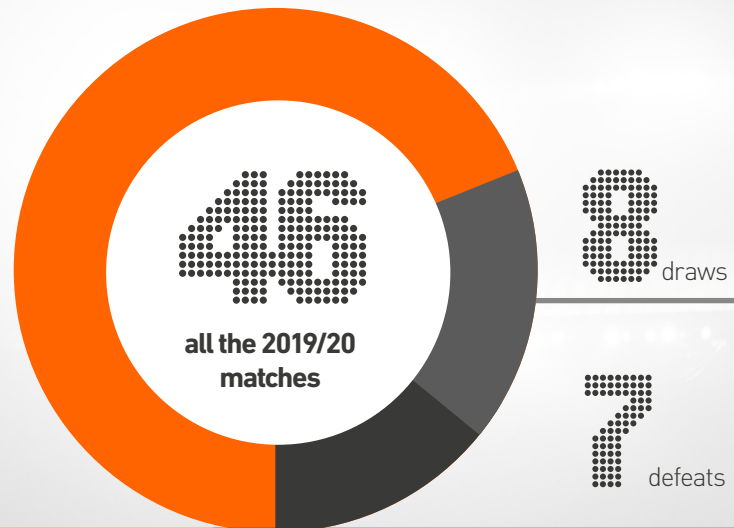

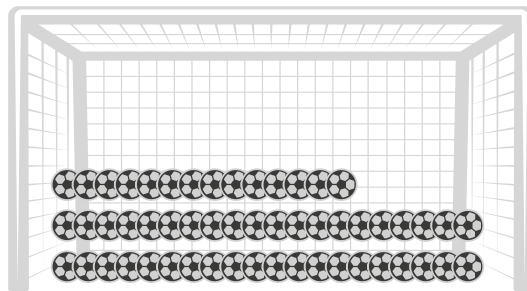
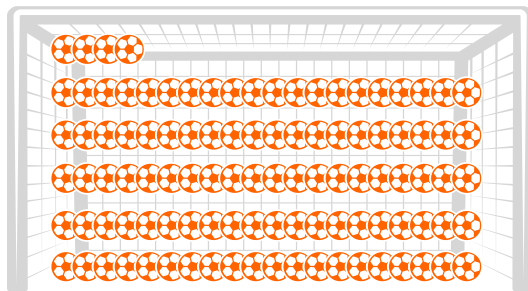

# ACADEMY

The 2019/20 season was not finished due to the coronavirus epidemic. When the competition was stopped in March 2020, the FC Shakhtar Academy teams were competing for the DUFLU top positions in their age categories (U14, U15, U16, U17). Shakhtar U21 were sitting in the top spot, while Shakhtar U19 were second but had a game in hand and an advantage over their opponents with the lost points taken into account.

**Shakhtar U21** approached the league season start with a new coach at the helm. Instead of Valerii Kryventsov who led the U21 team for three seasons, the outfit was headed by the Portuguese coach Fernando Valente. In 21 games, the Miners claimed 17 wins along with 2 draws and 2 defeats (goal difference is 46-16) and were leading with 53 points when the competition was stopped. Midfielder Artem Bondarenko is the top scorer (7 goals in 15 games).

**Shakhtar U19** have had their second season with the Spanish coach Andres Carrasco at the helm. In the UEFA Youth League, the Miners finished fourth in the group with their counterparts Atalanta, Dinamo Zagreb and Manchester City. Out of 15 Ukrainian league games, the Orange-and-Blacks won 14. The goal difference is 49-10. Before the competition was stopped, Shakhtar U19 was second, 1 point behind the leader, but had a match in reserve. Forward Abdulla Abdullaiev led the scoring race (21 goals in 15 games).

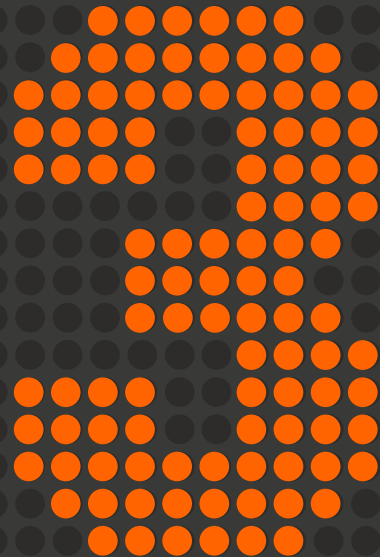

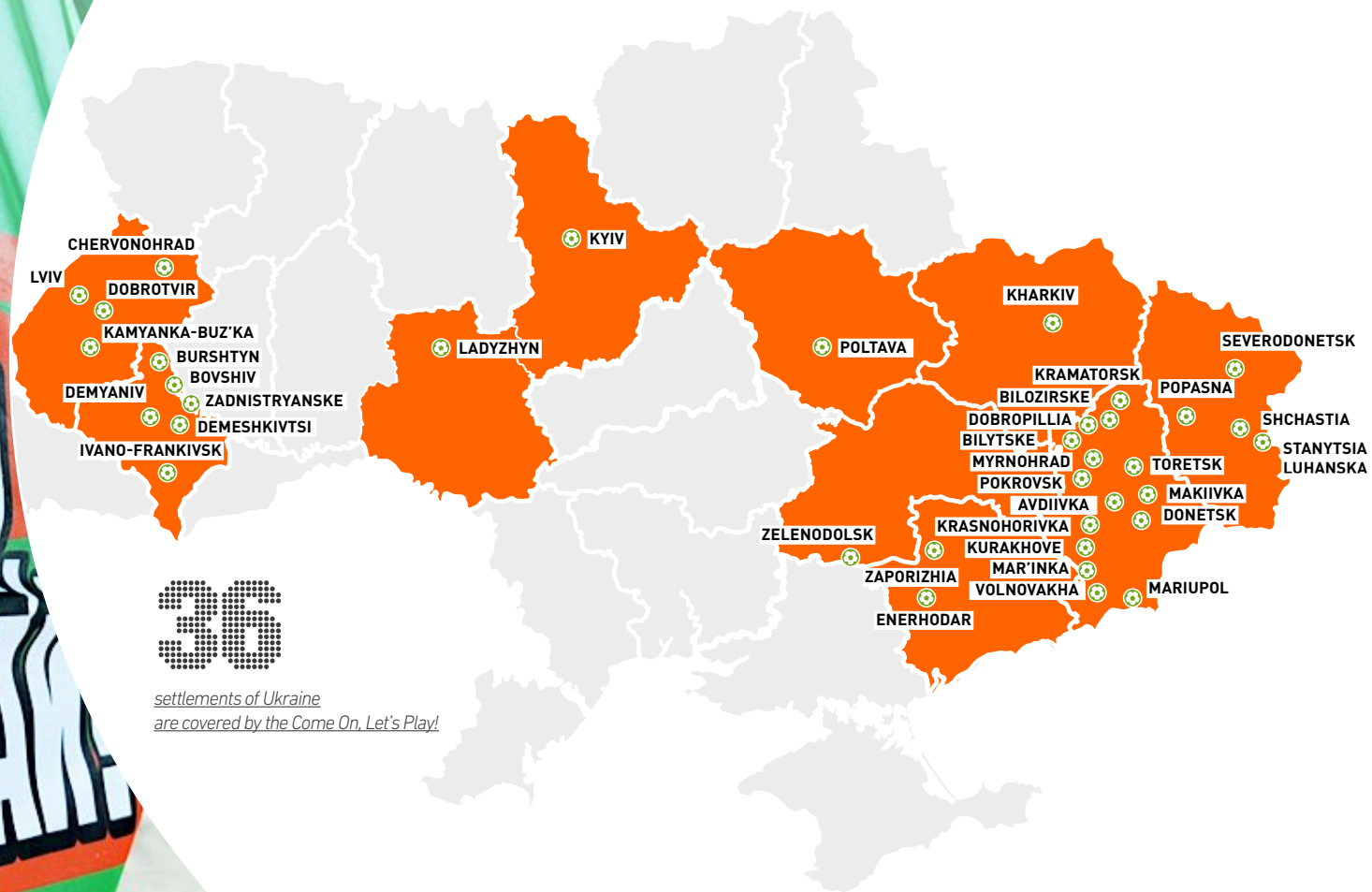


# GRASSROOTS FOOTBALL (HEALTH)

Come On, Let's Play! is the biggest CSR project for children's grassroots football in Ukraine. In the 2019/20 season, its reach extended to 36 settlements in the country: Donetsk, Kyiv, Kharkiv, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Mariupol, Makiivka, Toretsk, Kramatorsk, Bilozirske, Dobropillia, Avdiivka, Krasnohorivka, Kurakhove, Marinka, Volnovakha, Severodonetsk, Popasna, Shchastia, Zelenodolsk, Chervonohrad, Dobrotvir, Burshtyn, Stanytsia Luhanska, Zaporizhia, Demyaniv, Pokrovsk, Ladyzhyn, Demeshkivtsi, Kamyanka-Buz'ka, Bilytske, Zadnistrianske, Bovshiv, Myrnohrad, Enerhodar and Poltava.

The project's general partner is DTEK. They implement the Come On, Let's Play! project jointly with UEFA in the towns near the contact line in Donbass.

As part of the Come On, Let's Play! project, children aged 7 to 12 have the opportunity to play football for free on high-quality pitches with all the necessary equipment and under the guidance of C-license coaches. In total, 4,787 children trained at 66 project sites in the 2019/20 season.

In November, Barcelona hosted the 13th European Football for Development Network (EFDN) conference. In the More than Football Award 2019 competition, they picked the best CSR project in Europe. About 40 continental clubs have taken part in it, with Chelsea, Juventus, Rangers, and Shakhtar being shortlisted as the last-four best competitors. Shakhtar Social's Come On, Let's Play! project was recognized as Europe's best CSR initiative.







In December, Come On, Let's Play! won a UN award in the Society category. The project was short-listed in an international competition of partnership projects called Partnership for Sustainability Award 2019 between various stakeholder groups to achieve their sustainable development. More than 80 cases from across four countries were presented in four categories last year.







# EDUCATION

In October, Shakhtar Social conducted a three-day training course for coaches of the Come On, Let's Play! project at the DTEK Academy. The event was organized jointly with the United Nations Population Fund in Ukraine (UNFPA Ukraine) with the support of DTEK and UK AID. 50 Shakhtar Social coaches from 30 locations in Ukraine took part in it.

The course included a speech by the Shakhtar Academy Director Jorge Raffo, a Come On, Let's Play! methodology training, along with a new UNFPA programme called Training Boys to Be Men, with its key topics dealing with the tools to prevent violence and aggression among players, the principles of tolerant and respectful attitude to the opposite sex, teammates, and other social groups.





# GENDER EQUALITY

Since December 2018, the girls team of FC Shakhtar has been constantly training in Kharkiv. 20 young footballers aged seven to nine regularly participate in city competitions along with boys and beat the latter from time to time. And the team leader Milana Kovtun scored 23 goals in 9 games in 2020.







In February, the club released a video about the team called “Shakhtar girls team. If boys can score goals, why can’t girls do the same?” Football is considered to be a non-female sport and girls often face the prejudices of others and even of their own families when they want to play football. Shakhtar Social helps them to overcome stereotypes because football is a sport for everyone.

Along with boys, girls are engaged in the Come On, Let’s Play! project and participate in the final tournaments, with one goal scored by a girl counting as two goals. In the 2019/20 season, more than 200 girls played on the fields of the project along with boys. Also, with the support of UNFPA and Special Olympics, Shakhtar Social organized training sessions for girls with intellectual disabilities in Kyiv, Mariupol, Kharkiv and Ivano-Frankivsk.





# SOCIAL INCLUSION

290 children with disabilities (cerebral palsy, Down syndrome, autism, deafness) trained at the Come On, Let's Play! grounds in six cities (Mariupol, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kyiv, Poltava, Kharkiv and Lviv) in the 2019/20 season. Training sessions contribute to better socialization of the children with special needs and develop teamwork skills.





# CHARITY

Traditionally for St. Nicholas Day, the club joined the New Year's charitable event called "Rinat Akhmetov to Children!" In December, 2,000 participants in the Come On, Let's Play! project from 23 settlements of Ukraine received Shakhtar shirts. At the sites in Kharkiv and Zaporizhia, Shakhtar coaches Vitor Severino, Antonio Ferreira and Jose Costa personally presented gifts from the team to the young footballers.

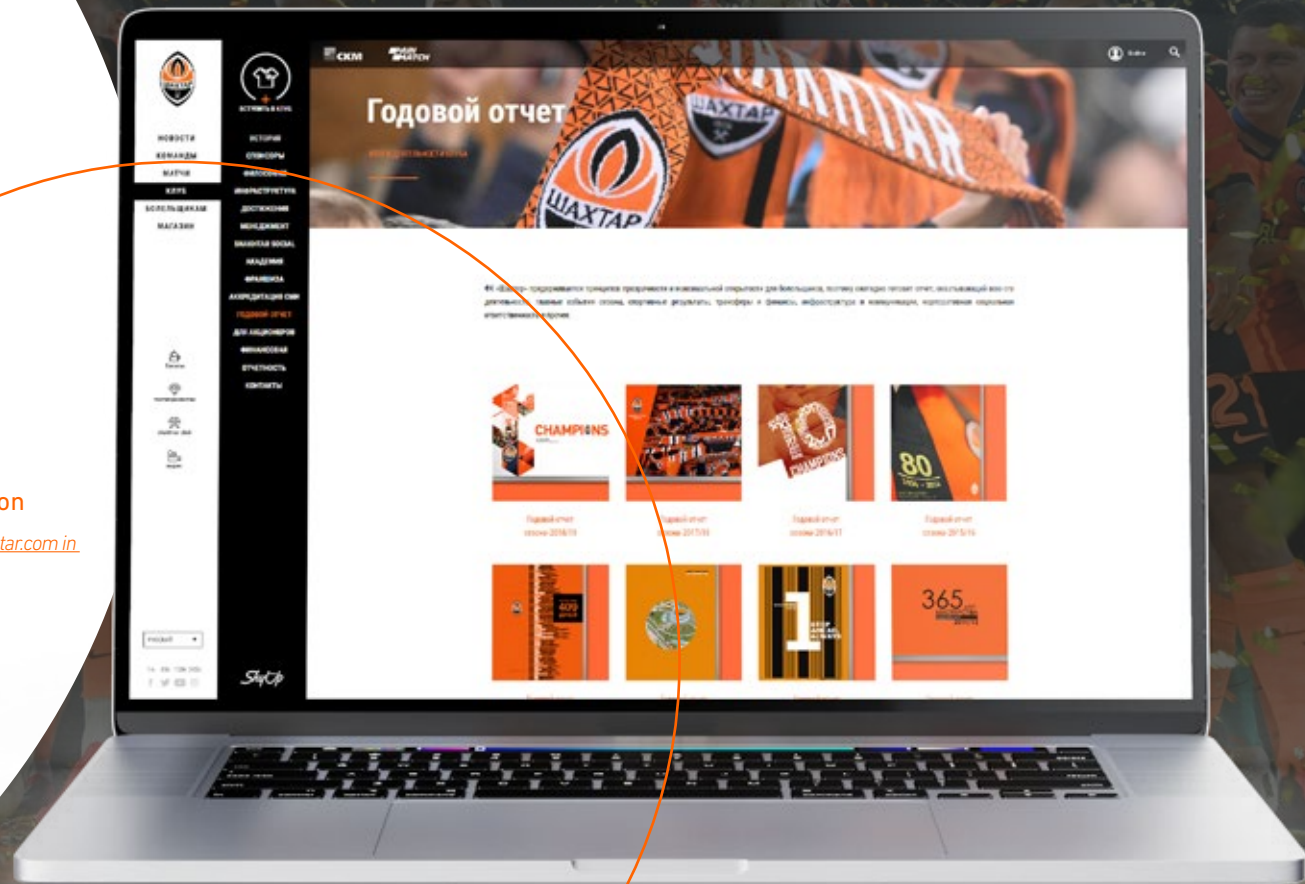

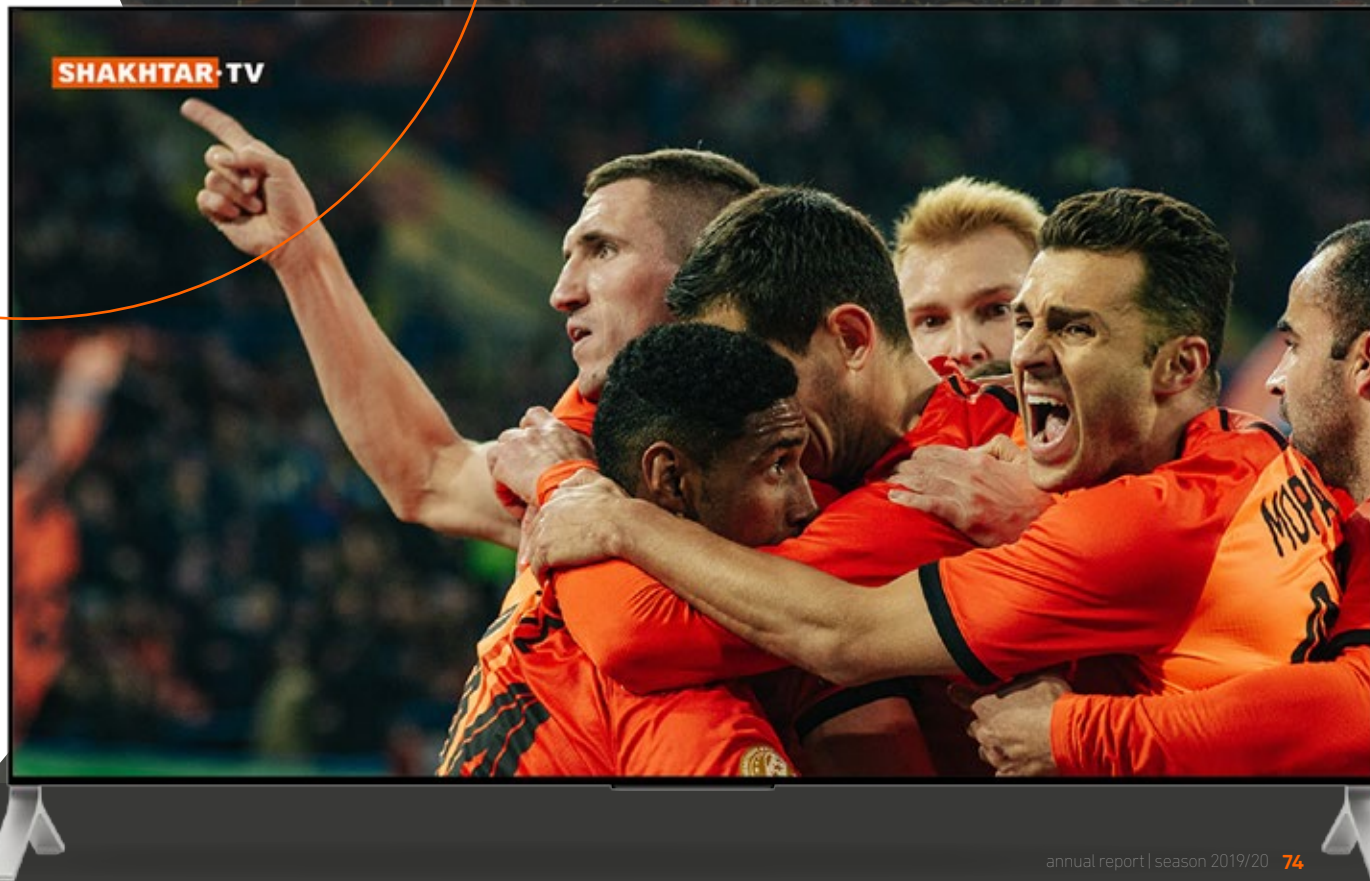

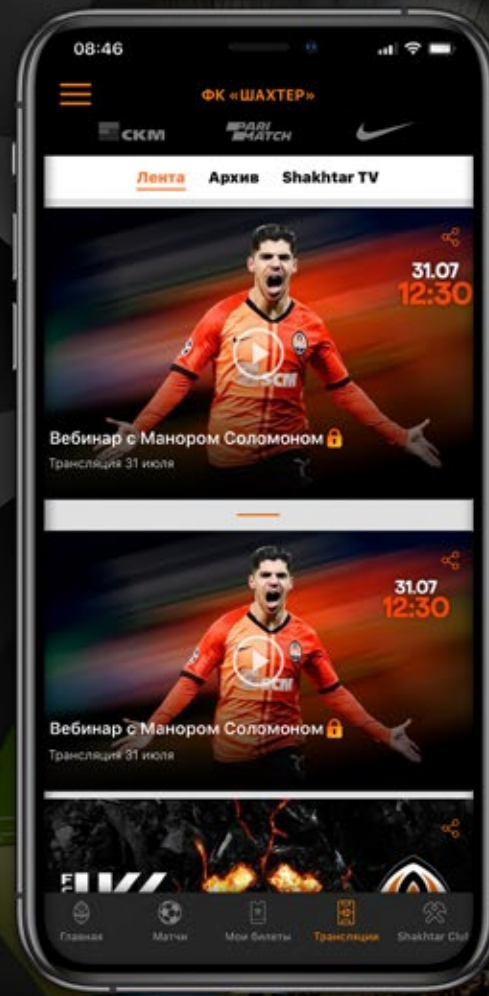






### Mobile entertainment

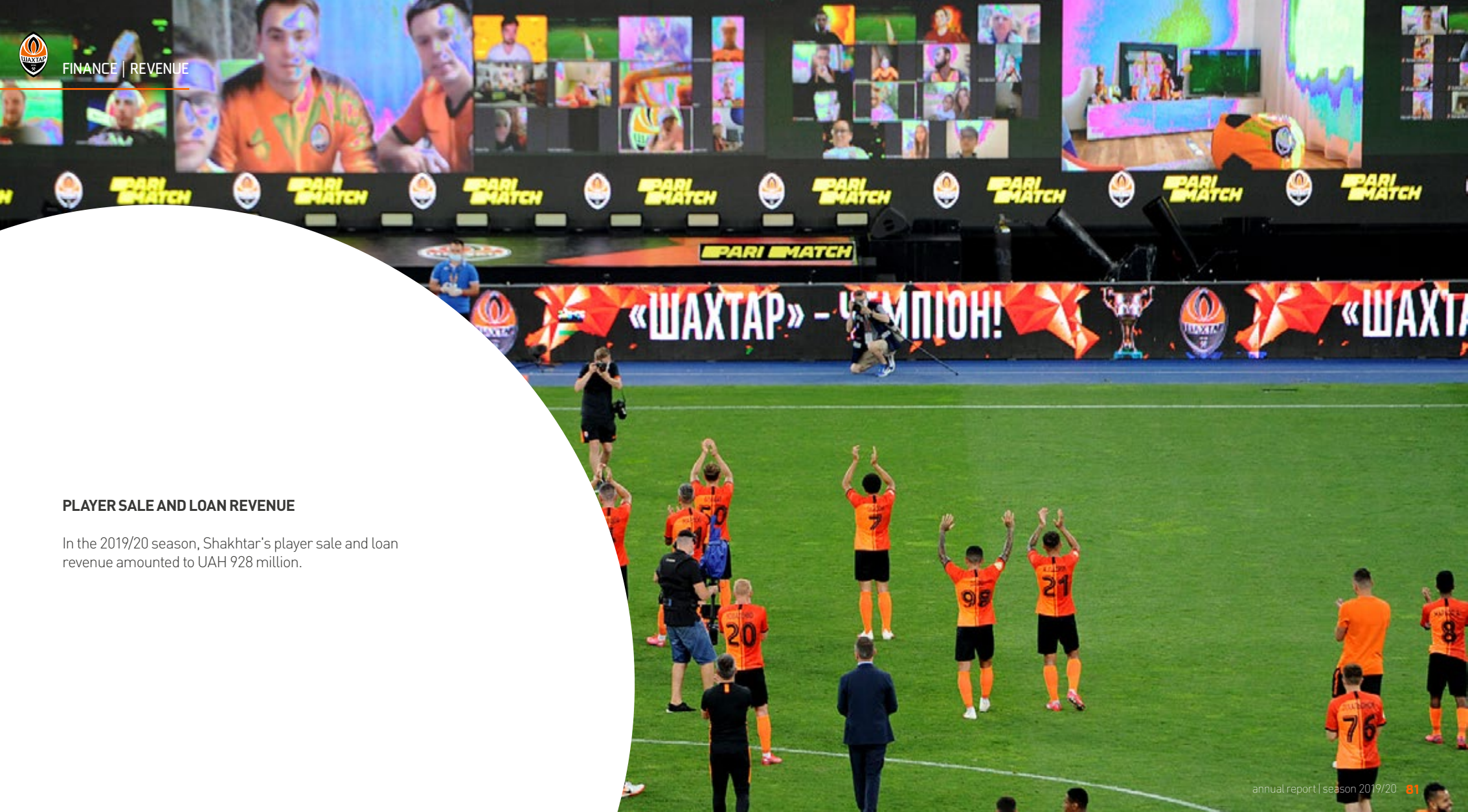
