Shakhtar the UEFA Cup Winner

New Chapter

The Pitmen opened a new chapter in their glorious history. Shakhtar became the first Ukrainian club to win the UEFA Cup in the competition's final edition. Moreover, it turned out to be the remarkable event for the whole Ukrainian football. And personal victories also no doubt added it to the current campaign. Mircea Lucescu was recognized to be the Premier League Best Coach and Darijo Srna, the team captain, being as well the real team leader, was awarded the title of the Best Football Player in the 2008/2009 Ukrainian Championship. The successful season adds confidence, opens up prospects and reveals new ambitions. The UEFA Cup title spurs us on to the new achievements.

Champions League If It Were Not For Bad Luck ...

Every year Shakhtar set an aim to get to the knock out phase in the most prestigious tournament of the Old World. This season the Pitmen successfully qualified for the group stage, having won 5 - 1 on aggregate against Dinamo Zagreb. Barcelona (Spain), Basel (Switzerland) and Sporting (Portuguese) were drawn at the group stage. The Matchdays 4 and 5 turned out to be decisive ones, as the Pitmen lost 1-0 to Sporting twice, their direct rival for qualifying. The

2008/2009 season had the positive moments as well. Shakhtar topped their European best score against Basel home.

The fixtures with the Catalans will be living long in supporters' memory. In the first leg Donetsk side was taking their lead throughout the game — 1-0; yet they managed to concede two goals in the dying minutes that turned out a bit contradictory. On the last GS matchday Mircea Lucescu's men earned a valuable victory over Barca at the Camp Nou that only a few did so. As a result, Shakhtar held third place in the group, having taken out a right to appear in the UEFA Cup. The old proverb says if it were not for bad luck... If the Pitmen qualified for the Champions League Round of 16, the UEFA Cup trophy would surely be grabbed by someone else and would never come to Donetsk.

Ukrainian Championship

Paled Before the Luster

Unsuccessful launch of the Premiership struck out all efforts in the second term of the season. Shakhtar finished second in the Premier League. But all failures paled before the luster of the UEFA Cup. Sometimes you have to sacrifice those summits you have already reached. The Club played 30 competitive games throughout the year and amassed 19 wins, 7 draws and only 4 defeats.

As a result, this year Shakhtar have finished with 64 points.

Ukrainian Cup

When Ardour Did Not Last Long

The 2008/2009 season turned out to be a 'runner-up' one for Mircea Lucescu's men in the domestic campaign. Shakhtar held the second spot in Ukrainian Cup as well as in the Championship. Despite a 1-0 win in the hardest clash against Dynamo Kyiv in the semi-final, the Pitmen unexpectedly yielded to Vorskla Poltava in the final. On the one hand the result is negative, but on the other, two silvers gained a tint of gold in the aggregate of European Cup triumph. You would hardly find a club, which refused such achievements at the end of the season. After an eagerly awaiting win over Werder Bremen in the UEFA Cup final the team was exhausted emotionally and lacked spur to gain a decisive victory in the national Cup.

Practice Makes Perfect

15 July 2008 Shakhtar won their first trophy in the season. The Pitmen beat Dynamo Kyiv in Super Cup. The penalty shoot-outs sealed the fate of the clash at the neutral venue in Poltava. Shakhtar's Brazilian international, Brandao became an author of the decisive goal.

Squad Changes The launch of the 2008/2009 season pinpointed the arrival of goalkeeper Rustam Khudzhamov, defenders Mykola Ishchenko and Oleksandr Chyzhov, forward Marcelo Moreno. In the winter off-season Nery Castillo returned from Manchester City, where he played on loan. In August 2008 Oleksiy Byelik left FC Shakhtar for FC Dnipro Dnipropetrovsk. The transfer deal cost Dnipro USD 5.5 million. On 13 January 2009 FC Shakhtar and Olympique de Marseille agreed on Brazilian forward Brandao's transfer on fee of EUR 6 million. In February Shakhtar defender Leonardo moved on Ioan to Vasko da Gama (Brazil). Not a Comeback Nery Castillo, who has just come back from Manchester City on loan, should have replaced Brandao this winter. Nevertheless, nothing came out of Nery's comeback. The Mexican player failed to get into the starting line-up and again at the end of 2008/2009 season he was moved to Dnipro on a year loan.

Eighteen Honoured

At the end of the season 17 Shakhtar players, these are: Andriy Pyatov, Dmytro Chygrynskyy, Olexiy Gai, Jadson, Igor Duljaj, Mariusz Lewandowski, Razvan Rat, Darijo Srna, Ilsinho, Fernandinho, Oleksandr Gladkyy, Mykola Ishchenko, Oleksandr Kucher, Luiz Adriano, Tomas Hübschman, Yevgen Seleznyov and Willian - were awarded the Honoured Masters of Sports titles for the UEFA Cup win. And the Pitmen head coach, Mircea Lucescu earned the Honoured Coach of Ukraine title, being the citizen of another country. It is a unique occurence in Ukrainian history: none of foreign coaches was favoured such an honour before.





Valeriy Yaremchenko:

FC Shakhtar Reserves Head Coach

'The guys are eager to work hard'

-None coach gets satisfied with the result obtained. There is always something left to improve in football. Well, the result can justify some faults, as you can always find certain negative as well as positive aspects in moves of any player. I would rather evaluate the squad's actions as positive ones. If I say the opposite, I will lie. I started coaching the squad, half consisted of players hardly turned seventeen. Must confess, I have made a mistake, having raised my demands in physical aspect. As I saw the players long recovered after tough games. They still have some time and opportunity for development, though they should not waste it, it is still limited... we have not had easy games to play this season. The most important is that the guys are eager to work hard during training sessions and do their utmost while coming on the pitch. If their spur and motivation become weaker, then all prospects will fade away.

The 2008/2009 season became a 'golden' one for FC Shakhtar reserves. Moreover, the Pitmen secured the title several fixtures before the Reserves Championship campaign was over. Note that Yaremchenko's squad was one of the youngest participants of this tournament. According to the head coach's words, his men became skillfully matured while progressing further. Coming on the pitch super motivated, their opponents were eager to eliminate the leaders, preventing them from gathering the path. Nevertheless, Shakhtar reserves stood firm as no one else. Besides, many Pitmen youngsters were capped for Ukraine U-21, having no time for recover. Fortunately, all the players found strength to keep on going and the coaching staff helped them much.





The Academy has a common assignment set: to develop players into the first team professionals. That is why we are trying to improve their level of skills, as well as to impart a winner's way of thinking. All year round teams from U-8 to U-13 are taking part in competitions among soccer schools, where they deliberately choose older groups as counterparts. So focusing on skills development comes first for the coaching staff. And the result comes second. If we are talking about the Academy professional squads from U-14 to U-19, a result achievement and win in any competition play an important part here. We have taken a big step forward in infrastructure,

having put a new building into operation. Such conditions allowed our youngsters to take up their residence here at the training camp, instead of living in the city. The level of amenities is equal to a top one. Apart from developing football skills, the Academy pays attention to youngsters' education. All our seniors successfully passed necessary exams and tests to enter universities.

The Academy: A Look From Inside 2009

As an integral part of the Club, FC Shakhtar Academy, directed by Dutch expert Patrick van Leeuwen, successfully achieves all aims set. The Academy consists of 11 squads, where young players from 8 till 19 improve their football skills. The renowned legends of the Club, always ready to put their experience to good use, coach these equals. During all this year U-19 teams. In the 2008/2009 season all four professional senior groups (U-14—U-17) won trophies in Ukrainian Youth Championship (South-East Division) that secured

them participation in the final phase. Shakhtar U-16 became a titleholder, with U-15 as a runnerup. U-14 and U-17 took the third and fourth spots, respectively. It is hard to demand high results from Shakhtar-3, facing the Ukrainian Second Division, as the youngsters play against professionals as was trying to act bold, doing their utmost. And result was not slow to arrive. Shakhtar-3 ended their campaign fifth. That is not bad at

The retraining programs for coaching staff are considered a crucial aspect of a new generation up-bringing. One of the key achievements in the Club medicine last year was the building of Medicine and Sports Adaptation Area, comprised Medical Department, Sports Analytic Group and Adaptation Department.

Keeping Abreast of Europe

FC Shakhtar Medicine and Sports Adaptation Area activities are focused on both familiar and new domains of study. We go on developing the player fitness evaluation. The new swimming pool and proprioception room were opened in FC Shakhtar Academy new building. The fruitful work has also been done in terms of Donbas Arena Medical Department structure and its operation.

During last year Medicine and Sports Adaptation Area kept on taking part in the UEFA injury prevention research among the Champions League clubs. The staff training and development of international relations are seen as key points for the Club. FC

Shakhtar doctors take an active part in the European medicine. Not only appearances in congresses held in Kyiv, Moscow, Warsaw and Leiden, but also European Association of Football Team Doctors project developed in partnership with such grandees as FC Barcelona, FC Celtic and FC Chelsea, prove positive changes once again. Besides, Shakhtar Head of Medical Department, Arthur Glushchenko's appointment as representative of the European Federation of Orthopaedics and Sports Traumatology in Eastern Europe shows again and again that the Club Medicine and Sports Adaptation Area is developing day after day, keeping abreast of the times.

- Recapping the season, the Club Medicine and Sports Adaptation Area showed an efficient level of operation. The most important thing is that we keep on enhancing a so-called 'system of FC Shakhtar Medicine and Sports Adaptation Area' that based on certain protocols of diagnostics, treatment and rehabilitation, as well as on injury prevention programs and adaptation, as a single integrated system. This allowed us to get into the five top European medical

football centers two seasons on end. We achieved the impossible. Twice we made it, so it proves our system works. I even did not expect to reach such a result without sufficient 'technological' investments. It also proves that a tense work and

professional development can substitute in some way a technological level, which the most teams taking part in the research have. It means a human factor is halfway to success. The 'system of FC Shakhtar Medicine and Sports Adaptation Area' is applied to every team at the Club. Besides, we are developing objective control programs for tracing progress of the Academy players as well as adaptation of recruiters (this program has not launched yet).

Today we are among the top medical football centers of Europe and we keep on growing and developing.

Academic Building

Nowadays the level of equipment and amenities at Kirsha Training Camp can be called an optimal one meeting the highest European requirements.

In January 2009 a new twostorey building for the Academy youngsters was put into operation at Kirsha, where the squads from U-14 to U-17 are accommodated now. Apart from the living space, you can also find two equipped gyms, four dressing rooms and showers here. At the players' disposal the building features an IT class, a study room, a cinema, as well as a billiard room and a tennis hall. The gem of the new building is a swimming pool with a capacity of 100 cubic metres, providing a two-level hydro massage for medical rehabilitation. We also built a covered synthetic ground of 40x60 metres. The operations also

embraced a pitch reconstruction including a drainage system enhancement with a natural surface applied. The Kirsha can boast the top-level turf and shrub machinery equipment such as an aerator, a grinder and a Husqvarna trimmer, etc.. We managed to enlarge some training ground capacities, now pitches No. 5 and No. 6 will be able to host more than 1,100 fans during tournaments held here.

Kirsha Training Camp

Kirsha Training Centre covers the area of over 43 hectares including the lake of 10.5 hectares.

It accommodates 8 natural pitches and a synthetic one.


Three pitches have an undersoil heating system and seven others are fit with an automated irrigation system. All pitches are equipped with lighting systems for evening trainings. Today, Kirsha Training Centre is literally sinking in greenery. Around 4,500 trees and almost 3,000 shrubs grow on the territory of

the complex. It is alsofamous for its white and black swan farm.

In total, the residence for the reserves and Shakhtar-3 covers the territory of 2,300 sq.metres. It comprises cozy single and double rooms, doctor's consulting rooms, a class room, a gym, a modern medical area with the following facilities:

- physiotherapy area;
- · procedure units;
- recovery area, including a sauna and a swimming pool;





'We took the experience of the best European clubs'

— Last year the lion's share of the departments underwent many changes. It was extremely necessary first of all for creation of a clear subordination structure that is aimed to enhance the Club efficiency as a single entity. We also revised the experience of the best European clubs and I suppose we have succeeded to build a smooth and efficient management structure. Undoubtedly, it is not somewhat of a 'frozen' structure, it might be improved further and further.





Management 'Tools' For Success

Last year FC Shakhtar experienced dramatic changes in their establishment. Every single effort was targeted at optimization of work. In fact, the Club has been making changes all the time, as every new season puts new tasks to focus on, it means the so-called management 'tools' should be altered as well. The most sufficient changes in the 2008/2009 season have happened due to a top-class, recently built home ground, the Donbas Arena. All commercial departments were decided to be removed from the Club direct subordination. That meant both the Marketing and the Sales Departments were to move to the Donbas Arena. Only the Club Press Office was an exception. Being an independent unit starting from this season, it reports directly to the Club CEO. The serious changes embraced all the departments reported to the Secretary General. As a result, the numbers of structural units

were reduced from eight to six. And the general organization and establishment became clearer. The ambitious aims in both the domestic and the European campaigns the Club focused on have emerged a need for the International Competition Department, headed by a well-known international referee Lubos Michel. Besides, there was a new position offered — the CEO Deputy — to develop a better cooperation with the national football associations such as Premier League Committee, FFU and PFL. Anatoliy Popov has taken this helm.

The changes in structure have not touched the First Team, the Academy and Scouting Departments.

However, to provide more close cooperation between the First Team and Reserves, the latest now directly report to FC Shakhtar First Team.

'We have divided the duties between the Club and the Stadium'

— At the beginning of the reporting period we have made decision to divide the duties between FC Shakhtar and the Donbas Arena. The Club stayed focused on football directly, while the Stadium was entrusted already developed branches such as marketing, commercial activities and fan coordination. Of course, the separation

of duties has been followed by changes in duties and establishment. Then the staff started to make moves from the Club to the Arena. It was gradual transition that helped sort out some departments into separate companies, for example, OJSC Shakhtar Trading. By 1st June all changes in establishment had been finished.

Staff Training

Last season FC Shakhtar employees spent time improving and developing their skills and knowledge.

The Club held the training programs on following directions:

- English Classes with a corporate tutor for individual and group learning 27 employees trained;
- Electric Security 12 employees trained;
- Marketing, Media and Intercommunication 5 employees trained;
- Changes in tax law and accounting 2 employees trained;
- Changes in current legislation 2 employees trained;

Besides, 17 reserves and Shakhtar-3 players study in universities at the expense of the Club funds.

OJSC Shakhtar Trading

Constantly growing demand for brand name products and souvenirs entailed a rise of more efficient system of sale. In March 2009 OJSC Shakhtar Trading was set up as an independent unit.

OJSC Shakhtar Trading aims to:

- mark up the Club profit for souvenirs and branded products;
- develop fan shop chains around the whole country;
- increase a corporate market value.

OJSC Shakhtar Trading is currently numbering 42 employees, who are able to meet high sales performance, promoting FC Shakhtar name.

Retail Chain

The main outlet is a fan shop. The demand for the Official supporters products is always high. That is why in the 2008/2009 season our retail chain was widened with several newly-opened fan stores in Kryvyi Rih and Luhansk, following the other outlets successfully operating in Donetsk and Horlivka. According to this season statistics, the sales return amounts to UAH 10, 620,460. All the latest ranges of Official supporters products can be shopped almost in every big mall. The number of stores comes to 209. At the matchday the supporters are welcome to buy Shakhtar accessories in 30 outlets located both at the stadium and nearby area. And finally selling online, an online store is one of rapidly developing projects within the Club. Last year its overall income came to UAH 97, 172.



In view of specific character of football, where every activity is regulated by the FFU and the UEFA, the company competitive ability depends on how quick, well and in compliance with social policy the Club can use its assets. In fact, Shakhtar business strategy aims to return on their resources considered a competitive advantage. Since the above mentioned advantage much more exceeds their real value, this strategy comes to efficient use of asset, i.e. resources and abilities for achieving the goals set in the 2008/2009 season. Firstly, it is the UEFA Cup win. Secondly, it is development of competitive players, much in demand on the sports market, considering that their market value should much exceed expenses for their development. It means the Academy should become self-supporting and profitable. Investment assets are very here. Since the prime cost of our main products such as 'match' and 'professional player' are really high, and economic and social factors influence it much, in the nearest

future the financial resource will remain crucial. Our department is focused on efficient use of key assets, since Shakhtar strategy financial component aims to a net asset increase.

A game production is at a loss now, though we have a large market share as well as a big amount of supporters ready to bring money to the Club, either making a purchase or giving their emotions and love to the Club, since these both things will work for its benefit and success in future. Our financial experts thoroughly analyze financial assets and their results in terms of image, as their impact on current and future company strategies is powerful, and eventually, they can shape some figures such as sales and net wealth.




The next venues both friends attended were Orphanage No.1 and Boarding House No.3. The last teed up a real exam on Club Study for the Chairman which he successfully passed!

The Donbass Arena capacity is farsightedly rated at a sufficient power margin for IT innovations will possibly be introduced in the nearest future to avoid updating of the entire multicomputer system. It means all innovative and up-to-date technologies will be implemented here within development of stadium infrastructure and Ticketing is also one of the most reliable world knowledge in IT.
